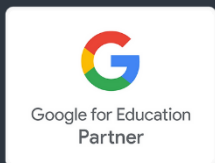
Minimum System Requirements for Windows 11

- Processor: 1 GHz or faster with 2 or more cores on a compatible 64-bit processor or System on a Chip (SoC).
- RAM: 4 GB or more.
- Storage: 64 GB or larger storage device.
- System Firmware: UEFI, Secure Boot capable.
- TPM: Trusted Platform Module (TPM) version 2.0.
- Graphics Card: Compatible with DirectX 12 or later with WDDM 2.0 driver.
- Display: High definition (720p) display that is greater than 9" diagonally, 8 bits per colour channel.

Dates to note:

- 31st March 2025 – All new devices will come with Windows 11, there will be no downgrade option.
- 14th October 2025 – End of support for Windows 10
